- While waiting for others to reply, keep on praying as you ask Holy Spirit to guide you all as you pray.

- Keep on praying back and forth on the group [by typing out your prayers] allowing space to pray through the prayers that come through
- Praying for children and families to know Jesus is a vital prayer point
- The person who leads the group watches the time agreed upon and closes prayer at the end
- You can be as creative as you desire in this time with emoji's and stickers too

**Valentine's Day 2020 – A Reflection from a Praying Mom, 14-02- 2020**





I want to encourage you with a dream the Lord shared with me recently.


